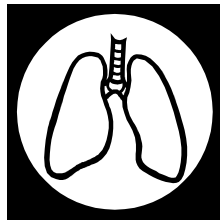


Is Your House Making You Sick? Take the RADON Test.

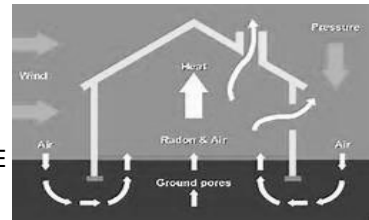
1. RADON is the 2nd leading cause of lung cancer; and, it causes more than 20,000 deaths in the U.S. each year.
